Description:

One of the most recognizable microphones, the Neumann U87 was first introduced in 1987. It is a large diaphragm solid state/FET microphone with three different directional patterns, a bass roll-off filter and a 10 dB pad. It has a transformer based output.

Applications:

The U87 can be a great vocal microphone, but it is not ideal for every voice. The U87 is well-suited for use as a room mic when used with a close mic on guitar cabinets. This is another great all round mic and performs well in any situation. It is a good choice for most general purpose applications in studios, for broadcasting, film and television. The U 87 Ai is used as a main microphone for orchestra recordings, as a spot mic for single instruments, and extensively as a vocal microphone for all types of music and speech.
